

This course is for any clinician with an interest in sexual and reproductive health clinical services. It is particularly aimed at nurses wanting to become accredited Nurse Cervical Screening Providers HIV/Hepatitis C test advisers. However any clinicians with an interest in clinical service provision in sexual and reproductive health (SRH) are welcome including doctors, midwives and nurses from any specialty. All Div 1 registered nurses are eligible to become an accredited Nurse Cervical Screening Provider with Pap Screen Victoria after completing the course.

**This 6 days course of face to face teaching is conducted at Melbourne Sexual Health Centre (MSHC), 580 Swanston Street, Carlton, VIC 3053. It covers**

- Contraception, unplanned pregnancy and sexual assault
- Sexual history taking and sexually transmissible infections
- Blood borne viruses and screening
- Policy and procedure development in the workplace
- Sexual and reproductive health care in adolescence and midlife
- Cervical screening and practical pap testing

Assessment:

- Written assignments of a suitable academic standard are required
- To achieve credentialing as a Nurse Cervical Screening Provider it is necessary for students (who are Div 1 nurses) to complete approximately 16 hours of clinical placement at MSHC.
- To undertake the clinical placement component you must have a minimum of 1 years clinical Nursing experience (RN only)

### An individual Subject at the University of Melbourne

- 3.** This is for students who are not currently enrolled in any university graduate course but want to have the option of using this subject towards a University PG course in the future.
